

## **Moving On Vocabulary Cheat Sheet**

**CBST:** Central-Based Support Team; if your child's case is deferred to CBST by the CSE during an IEP meeting, a *Case Manager* at CBST will send your child's packet of information to appropriate schools for consideration

**CSE:** Committee on Special Education; the CSE holds *IEP meetings*, where a CSE representative will talk with you and your student's team to discuss current progress and future recommendations

**Funded School/Nonfunded School:** A **funded** school means that you do not pay tuition out of pocket and that your child has been recommended for an NPS setting, so the DOE provides the funding for your student to attend the school; a **nonfunded** school means that you must pay tuition out of pocket and then can go through an impartial hearing process to seek reimbursement

**IEP:** Individualized Education Program

**NPS:** Non-public school (\*note: Reece is an NPS)

**Psychoeducational Assessment/Neuropsychological Assessment:** An assessment using standardized measures to evaluate your student's current cognitive, academic, and social functioning

**Securement Meeting:** A meeting between you, the CSE, and representatives from your student's new school to officially finalize the student's placement in the new school
