We will still have reading, math, social studies, science, health, program areas, and earning periods. We will stay in our classrooms to help stop spreading germs.

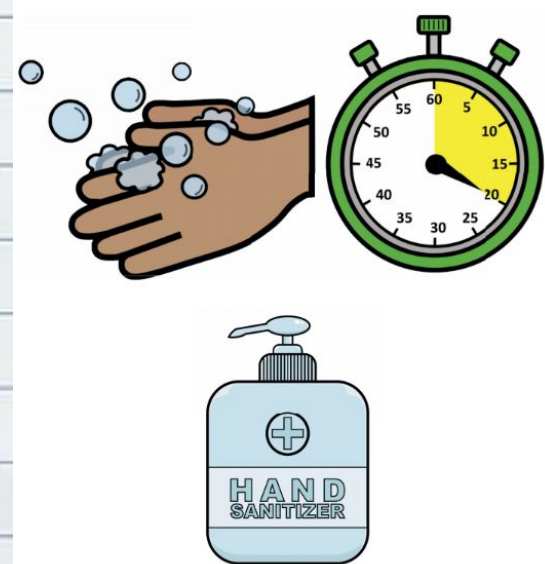


There are some things that will be different when we come back to school to help keep us all safe.

- before leaving school each day

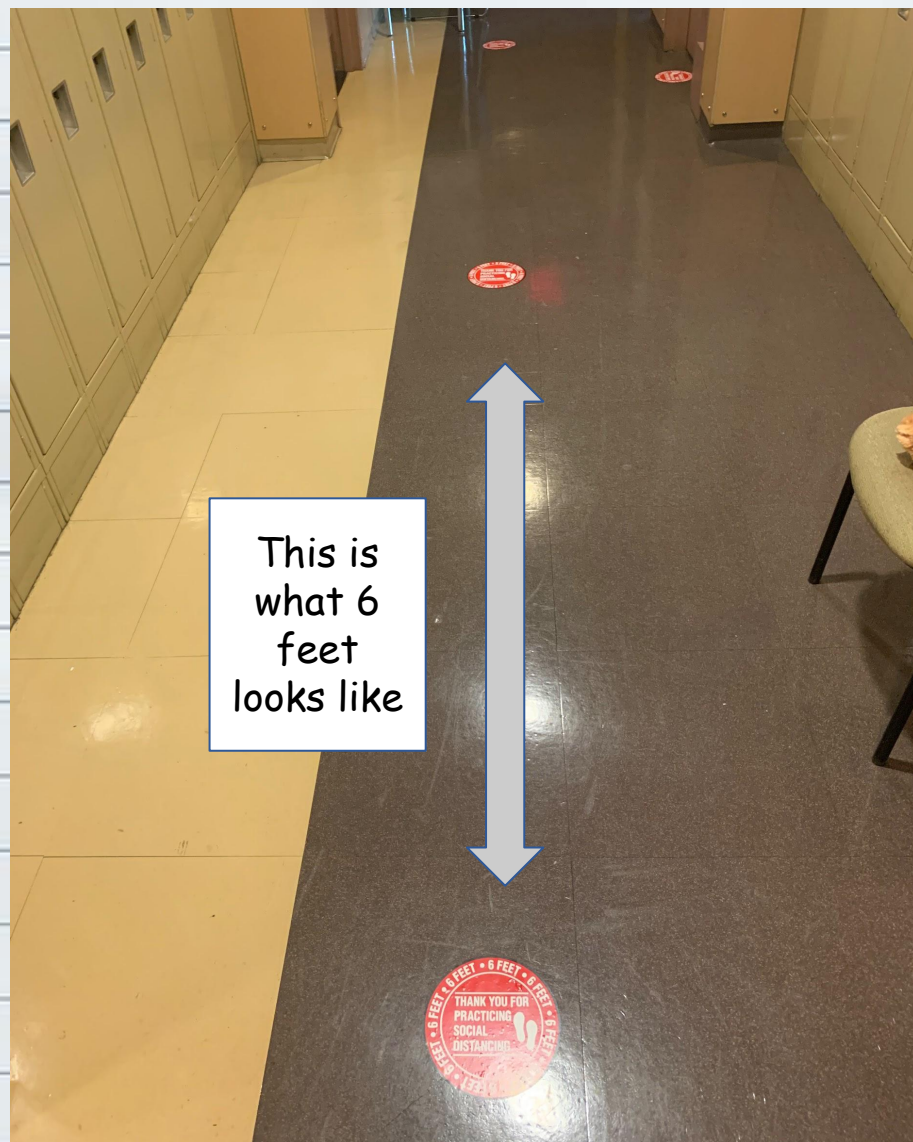




We will need to wear a mask to school and keep it on most of the day. Some people may wear a face shield. Wearing a mask keeps me healthy and prevents other people from getting sick too.

We will need to stay at least 6 feet away from other people.

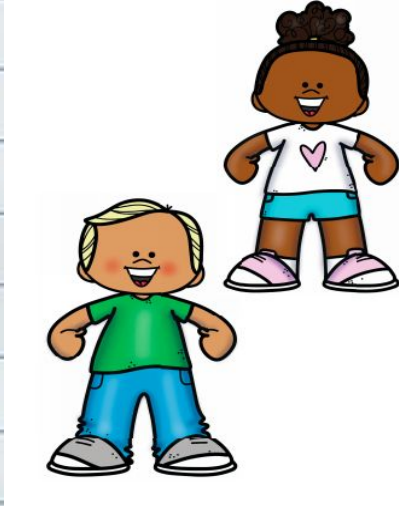
There will be special signs on the floor to remind me where to stand. This helps stop germs passing between my friends and teachers.

To say hello we can:



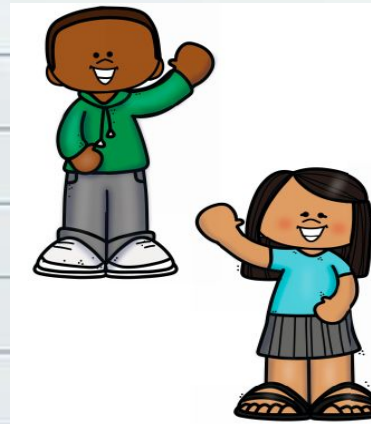
give air hugs

We will have to choose a safe space with our counselor or teacher when we need to take a break.

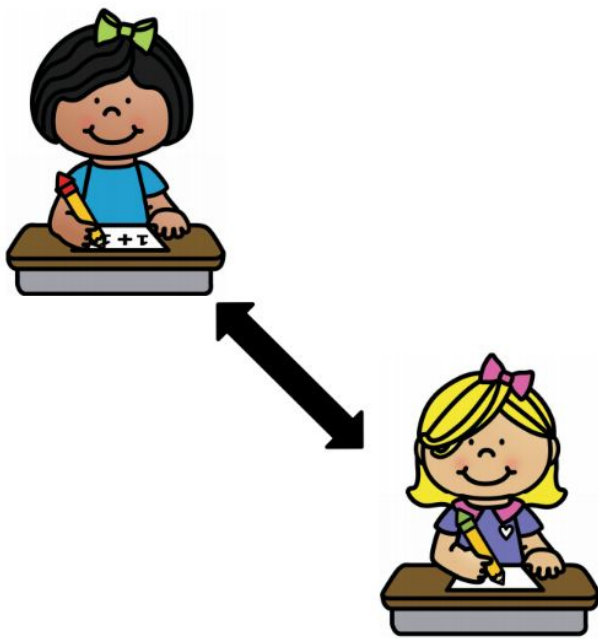


We will go straight to our classrooms when we come to school. We will not use our lockers.

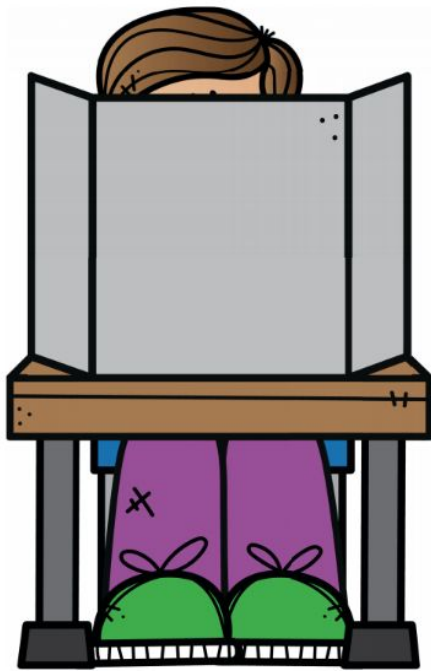
We will keep our belongings in our backpacks at our desks.

This will help us stay safe because we cannot have too many people in the hallway at the same time.





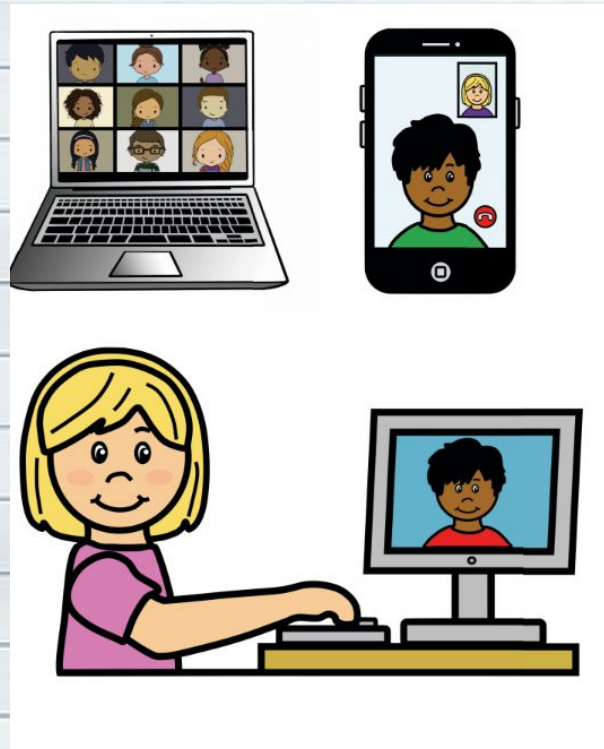
