There are some things that will need to be different when we return to school for our safety because of the virus. We will need to do the same safe behaviors that we have to do when we leave home and go to places in the community.




We will need to wash our hands often when we get to school, before and after leaving our classroom, when we touch shared surfaces or materials, before we eat, and after we use the bathroom, and before leaving school each day.



We will need to wear a mask to school and keep it on most of the day except when we are eating, outside, or sitting 6 feet away from other people.



We will need to practice social distancing to prevent us from spreading any germs to each other by accident. Social distancing means staying at least 6 feet away from other people so that you don't get their germs when they breath, sneeze or cough near you. There will be special signs in the hallways that show how far apart to stand from other people.








We will need to practice different ways of saying hello. Instead of hand shakes, high 5's and hugs, we will need to find fun ways to wave and do special handshakes 6 feet apart.

We will need to be careful and stay 6 feet apart when we go in and out of our classrooms. For example, social distancing is important when we are going to the bathroom, speech, OT, and counseling. We will not be able to take breaks in the hallway unless we have decided on a safe schedule or area with our counselor or teacher.







We can stay 6 feet apart by going directly to our classrooms when we arrive at school. Instead of using our lockers, we will keep our belongings in our backpacks at our desks in the classroom. This will help us stay safe because we cannot have too many people in the hallway at the same time.



Our classrooms will look a little different. Our desks will be 6 feet apart and facing one direction. We will not be able to move our desks close to each other for small group work. We will have tape around our desks to show our area.





At school we will still be learning with our teachers and classmates on Zoom. We might be in a different classroom and have a different teacher in the building who will be there to help us stay focused on our Zoom class. We will need to remember to bring our computers with us every day to school and charge them each night so they are ready for the next day.




We will stay in our rooms for most program areas unless we are going outside with our group. We will not switch classes for math or ELA. This will keep us safe because we want to be around less people right now to avoid spreading germs.





When we get to school in the morning, arrival will be different. We will walk through a scanner that takes everyone's temperature. We will need to walk carefully and stay six feet apart from other students and staff in the hallway. It may mean waiting a little longer to get upstairs and stopping a few times to give other people more space. This is important to do to keep everyone safe.
